Hampton City Schools offers a variety of resources in order to help students and families prepare for the cost of post secondary education. Remember scholarships can be offered based on academic merit and/or financial need. Many are offered for a special interest, engineering or nursing for example. Some are offered to members of local credit unions, service clubs such as Kiwanis and fraternity and sorority.
