

Family Life Education Parent Information Grade 9 - 10

"Virginia's standards for family life education provide a comprehensive, sequential K-12 curriculum. They include age-appropriate instruction in family living and community relationships, abstinence education, the value of postponing sexual activity, human sexuality and human reproduction. Instruction is designed to promote parental involvement, foster positive self-concepts and provide mechanisms for coping with peer pressure and the stresses of modern living according to the students' developmental stages and abilities." All teaching materials used in family life education are approved and reviewed by the School Health Advisory Board for Hampton City Schools. Parents and guardians have the right to review the Family Life Education program offered by their school division, including all written and supplemental materials used in the program.

Ways to review materials:

- Parents may view the teaching materials online through Parent Square by simply logging in and clicking the Resources Link.
- A complete hard copy of all printed materials and a description of all audio-visual materials are kept in the school media center or in the main office vault, and made available for review to any parent or guardian during school office hours before and during the school year by appointment. To review materials, please contact your child's health and wellness teacher.

Parents may opt their child out of family life instruction. *If you do not wish your child to participate in Family Life, please submit a letter to your child's teacher prior to the beginning of instruction* (see date of instruction below). Please include your child's full name, grade, and school name in the letter. For those children opting out, the teacher will arrange for alternate lessons in place of the Family Life Education lessons. If you would like your child to receive Family Life Education instruction, no action is required on your part.
