COVID-19
Student/Parent/Guardian Expectations and Agreement**

Hampton City Schools (HCS) understands that no one person or group can be solely responsible for the health, safety, and cleanliness of the school building. We view this as a shared responsibility.

HCS is committed to building a school culture where all must work together to create and maintain the healthiest school environment possible. To this end, all students, with their parents/guardians, must review and agree to the following expectations. These expectations are similar to other school rules in place to assure that students and parents/guardians exhibit conduct that is collaborative and supports a safe, healthy learning environment envisioned by school board policies. Failure to comply with the guidelines listed on this form as well as the HCS 2021-2022 Health Mitigation Strategies document, may result in a student being placed in an alternative learning environment or a discipline consequence.

- As the parent/guardian, I support that my child will wear a cloth face covering while in an HCS school building and on a school bus.
- As the parent/guardian, I will ensure the self-administered Student Health Questionnaire is completed DAILY BEFORE my child comes to school. I understand that a printed copy is not required to be sent to school, and that the questionnaire is located on the HCS 2021-2022 Instruction and Health Mitigation Plan webpage.
- As the parent/guardian, I will keep my child home if any COVID-like symptoms are present following the Health Questionnaire. I will notify the school of the absence. I understand that the school nurse will contact me with further questions.
- As the parent/guardian, I will communicate immediately with my child's school if any of my contact information changes to ensure that I can be reached during the school day.
- As the parent/guardian, I (or a designated, documented emergency contact) will pick up my child from school as soon as possible if my child experiences COVID-like symptoms during the school day.
- As the parent/guardian, I understand that my child with COVID-like symptoms or with a positive COVID diagnosis will not be able to return to school or board an HCS school bus until he/she meets quarantine guidelines related to his/her illness or exposure and has been evaluated by the school nurse. I further understand that I will be contacted to pick-up my child if he/she returns to the school building without clearance from the school nurse.
- As the parent/guardian, I support that my child should maintain at least three feet of physical distance to the greatest extent possible between others at all times.
- As the parent/guardian, I will wear a face covering when entering all HCS buildings.

- As the parent/guardian, I understand that no food deliveries will be accepted from outside providers and I will not be allowed to eat breakfast or lunch at school with my child.
- As the parent/guardian, when age appropriate, I support my child working with his/her teacher to keep his/her desk/workstation and desk shield clean prior to leaving the classroom.
- As the parent/guardian, I understand and agree that my child will have random temperature checks.

My child and I have read the **Hampton City Schools 2021-2022 COVID-19 Student/Parent/Guardian Expectations and Agreement** and we consent to follow all expectations. We understand that failure to comply with the guidelines listed on this form as well as the HCS 2021-2022 Health Mitigation Strategies document, may result in my child being placed in an alternative learning environment or receiving a discipline consequence. We also further understand these expectations are aligned with policies of Hampton City Schools, including but not limited to School Board Policy JF - Students' Rights and Responsibilities Handbook - Code of Student Conduct, School Board Policy JBA - Parent Responsibility and Involvement, and School Board Policy KGB - Public Conduct on School Property.
