WHAT TO DO WHEN AN INJURY OCCURS

FIRST! Ensure this is an HCS employee versus a substitute. Have the employee complete the -

CITY OF HAMPTON/HAMPTON CITY SCHOOLS REPORT OF WORK-RELATED INJURY OR ILLNESS FORM EIR FORM 1000

Make sure your copy is up to date: a complete packet has 4 Pages
If you have older forms, please contact Risk Management at 727-6617 to obtain the current forms
Older forms can be used temporarily after hours if needed

All ESS employees injured, please complete the forms specific to their company. Contact Health Services, 727-2363, if you do not have forms.

NEXT! Upon completion of the EIR Form 1000

- Have the employee choose a doctor from the Panel of Physicians located on page 2
 IMPORTANT FACTS ABOUT WORKERS' COMPENSATION
- The employee <u>must</u> write the doctor's name in the space provided on the EIR Form 1000 under Physician's Information.
- If the employee chooses not to seek treatment at this time, have them initial in the space provided on the EIR Form 1000 under Physician's Information.
- Provide the employee with a copy of the following documents for their records:
 - 1. IMPORTANT FACTS ABOUT WORKERS' COMPENSATION (page 2)
 - 2. CITY OF HAMPTON AND HAMPTON CITY SCHOOLS PHYSICIAN'S MEDICAL REPORT form (page 3 with the top portion filled out by the Nurse/Supervisor)
 - EXPRESS SCRIPTS PRESCRIPTION FORM
 (page 4 also filled out by the Nurse/Supervisor)

LAST! Make sure you send the report to Risk Management immediately!

If the employee has not completed the form due to having to seek immediate care, please notify Risk Managment via phone at 727-6617. As soon as the report can be completed by the employee, have it completed and follow process below.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A FAX MACHINE PLEASE, REPORT THE INJURY BY PHONE TO 727-6617 AND THEN SEND THE HARD COPY BY INTEROFFICE MAIL. FOR AFTERHOURS INJURIES, PLEASE LEAVE A VOICEMAIL AND SOMEONE FROM THE OFFICE WILL CONTACT YOU AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

All injury reports for Public Works and Parks and Recreation, please report injuries to Mark White
