



### Kecoughtan High School Science Wing Addition

The opening of the Kecoughtan High School science wing addition is scheduled for October 2023. The addition adds 37,313 square feet to the existing building. The new addition will house 15 state-of-the-art science classrooms and two new extended learning areas. This capital improvement project represents a total investment of \$16,000,000.
