Based on Family Income, applications may be sent to Hampton Head Start, HRCAP program. Head Start will contact families accordingly.

To be eligible for the HCS VPI program, families must reside in Hampton and meet at least one of the following eligibility criteria.

- Family income is at or below 200% of federal poverty guidelines (see chart below)
- Family is experiencing homelessness
- One or both of the student's parents did not graduate high school
- Students with disabilities or delays who are eligible for Special Education Services
- Local Eligibility Criteria
