Step One is the eligibility screening using one of the following:

In order to complete Step One you will need the following documents:

- Proof of Residency
- Photo Identification
- · Child's State Issued Birth Certificate
- Income Verification

-Qualifying incomes must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Please see back of flyer.

Step Two will be determined after review of the eligibility screener. The screener must be completed before we are able to determine participation in the VPI and move to the final step.

The child must be 4 years old on or before September 30, 2025.

> Parent/legal guardian must be present at appointment.

Child's Physical and Immunization Records are required to participate. Both forms should be given to the school once your child is accepted.

Please call 757-727-2419 if your child has a current IEP or if you have questions regarding the Special Education process.

Current Head Start enrollees do not qualify for this program.
